Minority, Female, Disabled (MFD) Business Program



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Executive Summary

In FY19, the total dollar value subject to minority participation was \$802,861,953. Minority, Female and Disabled (MFD) vendors were awarded **\$195,995,706** or **24.41%** of MFD total contract award of the total dollars subject to minority participation. Comparing to FY18's 23.5% this shows a continuous growth of MFD contracting percentage and MFD participating in the process since FY15.

This steady growth of minority contract awards and participation can also be attributed to the Local Small Business Reserve Program (LSBRP). About 50% of the LSBRP contract awardees are also MFD vendors. The LSBRP program helps local MFD vendors to gain opportunities to become prime contractors.

In FY19, there was a significant increase (15.94%) in the Non-Professional Services category for African American businesses at \$33,215,981, compared with FY18's \$29,977,565. It shows that African American businesses were much more competitive and were awarded more Non-Professional services contracts such as refuse/recycling services, security guards services, lighting services, etc. However, there was a significant decrease in the Professional Services category for African American businesses (from 5.49% participation to 1.93% participation). The category goal was adjusted (from 17% to 19% for CY2020) as a result. The Office of Procurement will pay close attention to increase African American businesses' participation in the Professional Services category.

In FY19, Hispanic American businesses had a significant increase in both the Non-Professional Services (15.78%) and Construction (25.44%) categories. In the Non-Professional Services category, Hispanic American businesses were awarded \$32,863,339, representing a \$16,605,318 increase from FY18's \$16,258,021. The increase is attributed to contracts such as roadway patching and resurfacing, concrete and asphalt for sideways and curbs, snow removal services, etc. In the Construction category, Hispanic American businesses were awarded \$23,988,541, representing a \$5,143,132 increase from FY18's \$18,845,409.

In FY19, Female owned businesses had a 5.64% increase in the Professional Services category. Female owned businesses were awarded \$22,816,514, representing a \$5,384,804 increase from FY18's \$17,431,710. The increase is attributed to contracts such as traffic signal control services, pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical services, marketing services, engineering services, etc.

The Office of Procurement will be working with the Office of Human Resources/EEO division to develop a mandatory Equity Training for all Contract Administrators. To boost awareness and compliance of the MFD requirements in the contracting processes and practices.

Background

Within the Office of Procurement, the Division of Business Relations and Compliance compiles an annual report on the Minority¹, Female and Disabled Persons Owned Business Program (MFD) which provides information required in accordance with Section 11B-61 of the Montgomery County Code and the Montgomery County Procurement Regulations.

The MFD Program assists registered vendors that hold at least one county-recognized certification (see Chart 1) in gaining opportunities as either prime contractors or sub-contractors for County contract awards with an estimated dollar value of \$50,000 or more.²

Minority Certifications Recognized by the County

The MFD program is designed to assist certified MFD businesses in gaining access to County contracting opportunities and building relationships with prime contractors. This process is done through available subcontracting opportunities which is the main thrust of the program.

The MFD Program Manager tracks and monitors contract awards and minority business compliance issues, so that required goals are met. The Manager settles disputes that may arise between a prime and subcontractor.

¹ Businesses owned by vendors in several socially disadvantaged groups may be eligible for certification and participation in the MFD program, including African American, Hispanic American, Asian American, Native American, Female and Persons with Disabilities

² Grants, utilities, intra/inter-governmental procurements are not subject to the MFD requirements.

The MFD Program's main functions are:

- Procurement and MFD procurement education
- MFD compliance
- Reporting
- Customer Service
- Outreach and education
- Review solicitations for artificial barriers

The MFD Program Manager conducts reviews and investigations of prime contractors' non-compliance and non-payments to minority subcontractors. The investigations may result in withholding progress payments, assessing liquidated damages, and termination of the contracts.

Each year the Director must use the Disparity Study data as available and the current Fiscal Year's utilization to determine for the next Fiscal Year's MFD goals of each group of MFD vendors. The MFD goals are broken down by four (4) procurement categories. New MFD goals for Calendar Year (CY) January 1st, 2020 are:

- Construction 21% (stayed the same as CY19)
- Professional Services 19% (increased from 17% in CY19)
- Non-Professional Services 17% (stayed the same as CY19)
- Goods 9% (stayed the same as CY19)

FY 19 DEVELOPMENTS AND SPEICAL PROJECTS

The Wheaton Revitalization Project will provide a government office building, below ground parking garage, and a town square as part of the Revitalization Strategy for the Wheaton area. The project is 75 percent complete and remains on schedule for a May 31, 2020 substantial completion. Stonebridge is the developer and Clark Construction Inc. is the primary construction contractor.

Clark Construction provides quarterly reports to the MFD office regarding:

- Total received from the County paid to Clark
- Total dollars paid to all certified MFD firms
- Percent of dollars paid to MFD firms
- Dollars paid to MFD subcontractors and percentage
- Type of services performed by MFD vendors

This project has an MFD goal of 20% over the life of the project. The project has currently achieved a 24.7% MFD goal to date.





Chart 1: 4-year Comparison on MFD Encumbrances





The RFP section of the MFD report is a result of proposals submitted in response to formal Requests for Proposals (RFPs) issued by the County during FY19. The report tracks the following information:

- Minority business groups and Non-minority businesses participating in the process only as prime contractors
- Break down of number of awards
- Dollar values for each group
- Number of proposals submitted by each group

The total dollar value for RFPs issued in FY19 was \$200,605,287. Of that amount MFD businesses were awarded **\$34,965,500** or **17.44%**. Out of 132 total RFP proposals submitted, 41 (31.06%) proposals were submitted by MFD businesses. A total of 39 RFP contract awards were issued. MFD businesses RFP contract award was 14 (35.90%). This is a significant increase from FY18's 19% MFD businesses with RFP contract awards.

- Break down of number of awards
- Dollar values for each group
- Number of bids submitted by each group

The total dollar value for IFBs issued in FY19 was \$171,368,891. Of that amount MFD businesses were awarded **\$74,288,575** or **43.35%**. This shows a significant increase from FY18's \$12,804,314 or 24.96%. Out of 138 total bids responding to the IFBs, 38 (27.53%) bids were submitted by MFD businesses. A total of 48 IFB contract awards were issued. MFD businesses were awarded 11 (22.91%).





Waiver Process

The Director, Office of Procurement, may determine that a contractor has or has not satisfied the MFD requirements. The determination to waive the MFD requirements is based on the rationale that subcontracting cannot be achieved for a variety of business-related reasons. Examples of reasons for each type of waiver are provided on this page. On the next page, a number corresponding to the number of the reason for waiver given below (1 to 6) is used in the summary table of FY19 waivers.

The goal-setting process is intended to determine in advance of a contract the reasonable expectation that the awardee shall exercise good faith. At any time, the Director, Office of Procurement, may request a waiver, or the prospective contractors on their own initiative may request a waiver. The contractor must explain in writing to the Director why the goal could not be achieved. This explanation must demonstrate that the prime contractor's failure to meet the goal is for reasons beyond the contractor's control.

Waivers are granted for one of the following reasons:

- 1. Individuals contractors including Recreational Instructors, Doctors, Nurses, etc., where subcontracting is impractical.
- 2. MFD firms listed on the subcontracting plan hold certifications not accepted by Montgomery County or not CVRS registered.
- 3. Manufacturers or their certified distributors for certain products that are not available for contracting otherwise.
- 4. Proprietary services or products owned and controlled by the prime contractor.
- 5. Economically impracticable.
- 6. Vendor claims that they have in-house capacity to perform the services.
