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MFD ANNUAL REPORT OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT

Executive Summary

MFD participation in FY 18 shows continuous growth in MFD contracting dollars. The MFD program is designed to assist certified MFD vendors in gaining access to contracting and subcontracting opportunities as well as building relationships with prime contractors. The MFD compliance program assists vendors by ensuring access to information and opportunities. Certified MFD businesses are encouraged to participate in the procurement process as prime contractors and/or as subcontractors. Non-MFD vendors are assisted in assuring compliance with the Chief Administrative Officer's (CAO) established participation goals for each purchasing category.

In FY18, the total dollar value subject to compliance with MFD goals was \$843,516,122. MFD businesses were awarded 23.5% or \$198,198,235 out of the total dollars' subject to the MFD program. FY 18 has shown a slight increase compared to FY 17's 23.24%.

In FY18, African American owned businesses have made significant improvements in 3 purchasing categories: Professional Services (\$24.8m), Non-Professional Services (\$29.98m) and Goods (\$8.1m). Female owned businesses almost doubled their participation in the Professional Services category (from FY17's \$9.8m to FY18's \$17.4m); and remained in the lead in the Goods category (\$10,79m). Although the total award dollar amount (\$1.89m) is still small due to low availability, Native American owned businesses made increase in all four purchasing categories for the first time. One of the contributing factors leading to the increase in MFD participation is the implementation and enforcement of Bill 48-14. Bill 48-14 provides incentives to vendors to submit an MFD Subcontractor Performance Plan with their RFP proposals to receive points for their MFD participation. Additionally, increased inclusive outreach events helped to improve the County's image as a friendly and transparent environment for MFD vendors. The program continues to show a positive direction of MFD businesses engagement and participation.

In FY18, the County spent significantly less (\$113m) on Construction. Only about one third of its FY17 spending (\$333m). This resulted in a lower dollar amount received by MFD vendors across the board except for Native American owned businesses. However, the MFD participation percentage in Construction category has increased to 27.56% (\$31.2m) from FY17's 18.93% (\$63m).

Minority participation is based on utilization and availability of minority businesses throughout the Washington DC/Baltimore Metropolitan Area and the statistical participation of procurement activity is based on contract total dollar value subject to MFD participation. Due to the increased MFD participation in certain groups, the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) issued updated goals for procurement's four purchasing categories to be implemented for the Calendar Year 2019:

Professional Services: 17% (increased from FY17's 15%);
Non-Professional Services: 17% (decreased from FY17's 22%);
Goods: 9% (decreased from FY15%);
Construction: (otayed the same)

• Construction: 21% (stayed the same)

Background

Within the Office of Procurement, the Division of Business Relations and Compliance compiles an annual report on the Minority¹, Female and Disabled Persons Owned Business Program (MFD) which provides information required in accordance with Section 11B-61 of the Montgomery County Code and the Montgomery County Procurement Regulations.

The MFD Program assists registered vendors that hold at least one county-recognized certification (see Chart 1) in gaining opportunities as either prime contractors or sub-contractors for County contract awards with an estimated dollar value of \$50,000 or more.²

Businesses owned by vendors in several socially disadvantaged groups may be eligible for certification and participation in the MFD program, including African American, Hispanic American, Asian American, Native American, Female and Persons with Disabilities

Important FY 18 Developments and Projects

Continuing our efforts to address underutilization concerns raised in the 2014 GSPC Disparity Study³ and the recommendations reported by the County Council's 2015 Minority Owned and Local Small Business Task Force (Resolution 17-1253)⁴, the Office of Procurement implemented the following programs/processes to improve and strengthen MFD enforcement and compliance.

Due to the increased MFD participation in certain groups, according to the Executive Regulation Sec. 11B-7, the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) issued updated goals for procurement's four purchasing categories to be implemented for the Calendar Year 2019. The relevant categories and goals are:

- Professional Services: 17% (increased from FY17's 15%)
- Non-Professional Services: 17% (decreased from FY17's 22%)
- Goods: 9% (decreased from FY15%)
- Construction: 21% (stayed the same)
- 1. These goals will be implemented and enforced for Calendar Year 2019 and will be effective for all CY2019 issued solicitations and their resulting contracts.
- 2. Use of PRISM, an on-line electronic reporting system management tool that tracks a prime contractor's payments to minority vendors. The PRISM system is fully operational and plays a vital role in meeting compliance requirements. Additionally, continued use of an MFD payment document for minority sub-contractors to report their payment status or comments in verifying the prime contractor's commitment to and compliance with the MFD subcontracting plan.

Two major projects that have significant MFD participation:

- 1. The Wheaton Development Project is a long-term, multi-million-dollar project that continues to show strong minority participation. Between April 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018, Clark Construction reported quarterly dollar value on the Wheaton Project at \$4, 255,320. Of that amount, MFD dollar award was \$470,758 or 11.06% of MFD contract dollars. This project has an MFD goal of 21%.
- 2. AT&T Corp. was awarded a contract for Emergency Services Internet Protocol Network Services. The MFD goal is 15% that was achieved with a commitment to increase participation throughout the life of the contract using the County's MFD vendors.


Outreach Activities



Chart 1: 4-year Comparison on MFD Encumbrances







Total Dollars and Percent Value of Request for Proposals (RFPs) for Each MFD Group


The RFP section of the MFD report is a result of proposals submitted in response to formal Requests for Proposals (RFPs) issued by the County during FY18. The report tracks the following information:

- Minority business groups and Non-minority businesses participating in the process only as prime contractors
- Break down of number of awards
- Dollar values for each group
- Number of proposals submitted by each group

The total dollar value for RFPs issued in FY18 was \$303,969,179. Of that amount MFD businesses were awarded **\$73,693,111** or **24.24%.** Out of 184 total RFP proposals submitted, 45 (24.46%) proposals were submitted by MFD businesses. A total of 67 RFP contract awards were issued. MFD businesses RFP contract award was 13 (19.40%).

Total Dollars and Percent Value of Invitation for Bids (IFBs) for Each MFD Group


The IFB section of the MFD report is a result of bids submitted in response to formal Invitation for Bids (IFBs) issued by the County during FY18. The report tracks the following information:

- Minority business groups and Non-minority businesses participating in the process only as prime contractors
- Break down of number of awards
- Dollar values for each group
- Number of bids submitted by each group

The total dollar value for IFBs issued in FY18 was \$51,291,194. Of that amount MFD businesses were awarded **\$12,804,314** or **24.96%**. Out of 138 total bids responding to the IFBs, 26 (18.84%) bids were submitted by MFD businesses. A total of 63 IFB contract awards were issued. MFD businesses were awarded 10 (15.87%).

Chart 4: IFB Award Dollars by MFD Group







Waiver Process

The Director, Office of Procurement, may determine that a contractor has or has not satisfied the MFD requirements. The determination to waive the MFD requirements is based on the rationale that subcontracting cannot be achieved for a variety of business-related reasons. Examples of reasons for each type of waiver are provided on this page. On the next page, a number corresponding to the number of the reason for waiver given below (1 to 6) is used in the summary table of FY18 waivers.

The goal-setting process is intended to determine in advance of a contract the reasonable expectation that the awardee shall exercise good faith. At any time, the Director, Office of Procurement, may request a waiver, or the prospective contractors on their own initiative may request a waiver. The contractor must explain in writing to the Director why the goal could not be achieved. This explanation must demonstrate that the prime contractor's failure to meet the goal is for reasons beyond the contractor's control.

Waivers are granted for one of the following reasons:

- 1. Individuals contractors including Recreational Instructors, Doctors, Nurses, etc., where subcontracting is impractical.
- 2. MFD firms listed on the subcontracting plan hold certifications not accepted by Montgomery County or not CVRS registered.
- 3. Manufacturers or their certified distributors for certain products that are not available for contracting otherwise.
- 4. Proprietary services or products owned and controlled by the prime contractor.
- 5. Economically impracticable.
- 6. Vendor claims that they have in-house capacity to perform the services.
