Beer and Wine Tasting License

Regulations

- 1. A Beer and Wine Tasting license authorizes tasting of alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises of the holder of a Class A license. See § 25-1306 of the <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u>.
- 2. A holder of a Beer and Wine Tasting license may allow consumption by a single individual for tasting purposes of not more than:
 - 1 ounce from a single brand of wine;
 - 4 ounces from all brands of wine in a single day;
 - 3 ounces from a single brand of beer; and
 - 12 ounces from all brands of beer in a single day.
- 3. Once opened, each bottle used for beer and wine tasting shall be marked that it is to be used for that purpose only.
- 4. The holder of a Beer and Wine Tasting license shall notify the <u>Board of License</u> Commissioners online at least seven days before each tasting event.
- 5. The fee for the Beer and Wine Tasting license is \$200 per year.
