Holiday Extended Hours

Regulations

- Some license types are permitted to extend alcohol sales by one hour under certain conditions on specified public holidays under § 25-2005 of the <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u>.
- 2. A holder of a Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. the following day (Monday) if the federal government has designated the following day as a public holiday.
- 3. The holder of a Class D or Class BD Beer, Wine, and Liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. the next day (Monday) if the federal government has designated the following day as Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, or Christmas.
- 4. The license holder shall sell or make food available for on-premises consumption during the hours that alcoholic beverages are served.
- 5. There are no extended hours authorized for any other class of license.
