D1 Beat:

- An **attempted residential burglary** occurred in the 8800 block of Lanier Drive, Silver Spring on Wednesday, 4/28 at 9:30 p.m. Forced entry attempted, but no entry gained, nothing was taken.

Suspect: W/M, wearing a black hoodie pulled over face and black gloves.

- A **pick pocketing** incident occurred in the 5400 block of Wisconsin Avenue, Chevy Chase on Friday, 4/30 at approximately 5:20 p.m. The elderly male victim had just finished shopping in Giant when the suspect approached and offered assistance loading bags into the victim's vehicle. The victim declined the offer, however at one point the suspect 'bumped' into the victim. The victim later discovered that his wallet was missing.

Suspect: B/M, 60-80, 5'6", 150-200 lbs., wearing a wrinkled grey suit.

D2 Beat:

- Two **thefts from vehicles** occurred in the County garage at 4841 Bethesda Avenue, Bethesda on Wednesday, 4/28 between 3:00 p.m. and 4:45 p.m. Two parked vehicles were entered, but neither vehicle showed any signs of forced entry. A witness saw suspects entering one of the vehicles through the tailgate. A GPS and laptop were removed from the vehicles.

Suspects: (2) B/Ms.

- A **vehicle theft** was reported in the 4500 block of Fairfield Drive, Bethesda on Monday, 5/3 at 7:00 a.m. The suspect was seen driving a '97 Nissan pickup that had been reported stolen (NFI). A search of the suspect's residence linked him to various other thefts throughout the region.

D3 Beat:

- A **residential burglary** occurred in the 9400 block of Rockville Pike, Bethesda overnight from Thursday, 4/29 into Friday, 4/30. Entry was forced; unknown what was taken.
- Five **thefts from vehicles** occurred in this Kensington beat either overnight from Monday, 4/26 into Tuesday 4/27, or overnight from Tuesday 4/27, into Wednesday 4/28. All of the

vehicles had been left unsecured. Vehicles were searched and cash, an iPod, and glasses were taken. Affected streets were: the 10400 block of Vogel Place, the 3900 block of Washington Street (2 incidents), the 4400 block of Brookfield Drive and the 3900 block of Baltimore Street.

E1 Beat

- An **aggravated assault** occurred at River Road and Ridgefield Road, Bethesda on Sunday, 5/3 at approximately 3:00 a.m. Police responded to a call for a male victim who had been shot in the chest. The victim stated that a masked suspect shot him, possibly in an attempted robbery. The victim had non-life-threatening injuries.

Suspect: B/M, 21-28, 5'9", wearing a black mask.

- Seven **thefts from vehicles** were reported this week in this Bethesda beat. Only one vehicle showed signs of forced entry (broken window).
 - Overnight from Monday, 4/26 into Tuesday, 4/27 four incidents occurred on Haviland Drive, Stardust Lane, and Radnor Road. Cash, papers, iPods, and glasses were taken.
 - Overnight from Wednesday, 4/28 into Thursday, 4/29 two incidents were reported on Haviland Drive and Stardust Lane. Cash and a GPS were taken.
 - On Saturday, 5/2 between 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. near the intersection of Bradley Boulevard and Wisconsin Avenue. A vehicle window was broken and an iPod was removed.

E2 Beat:

- An **attempted residential garage burglary** occurred in the 5400 block of Whitley Park Terrace, Bethesda sometime between Tuesday, 4/27 and Saturday, 5/1. Attempted forced entry, no entry gained, and nothing was taken.
- Two **thefts from vehicles** occurred in the overnight hours between Wednesday, 4/28 and Friday, 4/29. Two Honda vehicles parked in the area of Pooks Hill Road and Whitley Park Terrace, Bethesda were entered. No signs of force noted. An auto stereo was taken from one and airbags from the other. No suspects were seen.

E3 Beat:

- No significant activity to report.

E4 Beat:

- Two **thefts from vehicles** occurred in the 10400 block of Rockville Pike, Bethesda overnight from Thursday, 4/29 into Friday, 4/30. Airbags were taken from two Acura vehicles parked in a residential lot. Both vehicles were found with broken side windows.
- Four **thefts from vehicles** were reported this week in the Parkside area of Bethesda (Montrose Avenue and Kenilworth Avenue), three of which occurred during overnight hours Wednesday, 4/21 into Thursday 4/22. The fourth incident occurred overnight from Sunday, 4/25 into Monday 4/26. Entry methods varied; cash and GPS units were taken.
- Two **thefts from vehicles** occurred overnight from Wednesday, 4/28 into Thursday, 4/29 in the 4800 block of Flanders Avenue and the 5100 block of Bangor Road – both in

Kensington. Vehicle doors were unlocked; a GPS was taken.
