G1 Beat:

- Two **commercial burglaries** occurred at a strip mall at 8395 Colesville Road in Silver Spring between 11:00 p.m. Tuesday, 5/5 and 5:21 a.m. on Wednesday, 5/6. In both incidents, there was forced entry and property taken.
- Four **thefts from vehicles** occurred between Tuesday, 5/5 and Thursday, 5/7, at county/commercial lots in the 8300 block of Colesville Road, 1300 block of East West Highway, and the 8000 block of Kennett Street. The suspect(s) broke the vehicle window in three of the incidents and obtained a camera, electronic equipment and a cell phone from luxury vehicles. One suspect was seen.

Suspect: B/M 25-30, 5'9" to 6'2", 200-250 lbs., wearing a red baseball cap, blue jeans, carrying a blue back pack

H1 Beat:

- An **attempted theft from vehicle** occurred in the 8000 block of Barron Street in Takoma Park on Thursday, 5/7 at 3:13 a.m. A witness observed the suspects break into the vehicle. When the suspects noticed the witness watching, they fled the scene in the listed vehicle.

H2 Beat:

- An **armed carjacking** occurred in the 1500 block of Paula Drive in Silver Spring on Tuesday, 5/12 at 9:57 p. m. An adult male victim was getting out of his vehicle in his driveway when two suspects, one armed with a gun, approached the victim and demanded

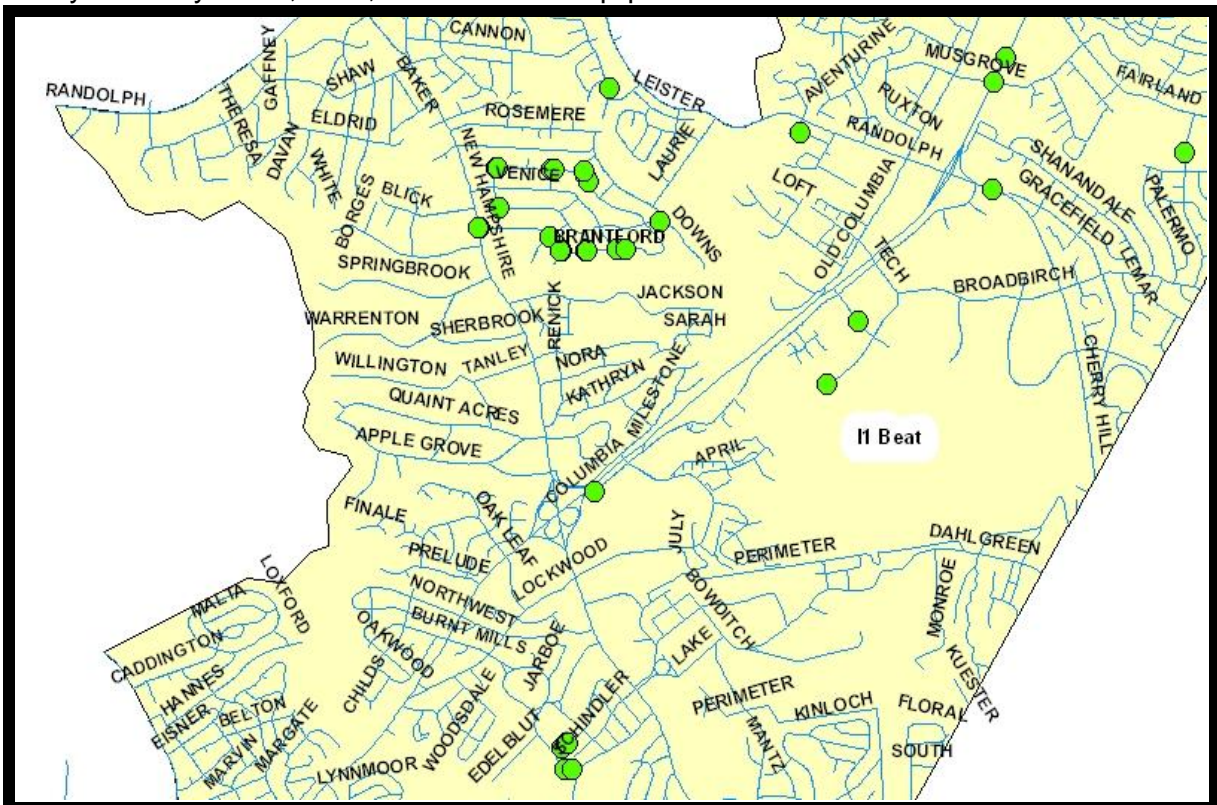
the victim's keys and cash. Both fled the scene in the victim's vehicle. The vehicle was recovered unoccupied in Prince George's County.

Suspects: (2) H/M's 18-20 years, 5'6" to 5'10", one armed with a gun.

Thefts from Vehicles occurred in the area of the 10400 block of Burnt Ember Drive in Silver Spring on Tuesday, 5/5 at 4:00 a.m. Property and car registrations were taken. Two adult male homeless men were found walking in the area, confirmed to be responsible, and arrested without incident.

11 Beat:

- A **residential burglary** occurred between 2:00 p.m. Thursday, 5/7 and 7:30 a.m. Friday, 5/8 in the 1500 block of Menlee Drive in Silver Spring. No forced entry to a shed and property taken.
- A **residential burglary** occurred on Sunday, 5/10 at 12:11 a.m. in the 12500 block of Palermo Drive in Silver Spring. Officers were involved in a foot pursuit with the suspect when he entered an unlocked front door and exited a rear door. The suspect was apprehended by K9.

I2 Beat:

- An **armed robbery** occurred in the area of 3900 block of Blackburn Lane in Burtonsville on Tuesday, 5/5 at 9:00 p.m. A food delivery man was robbed by two men, one armed with a knife as he walked to make a delivery.

Suspects: (2) B/M's 18-19 years, 5'4" to 6'2" 135-140 lbs., wearing black Jackets, one armed with a knife.

A robbery occurred in front of 13920 Castle Boulevard in Silver Spring on Wednesday, 5/6 at 1:09 a.m. The victim was involved in a fight with known suspects when the suspects took personal property.

Suspects: (3) B/M's

A **strong-arm robbery** occurred at Old Columbia Pike and Briggs Chaney Road in Burtonsville on Friday, 5/8 at approximately 2:00 a.m. The adult male victim was approached by a group of suspects who demanded his wallet. When the victim refused, the suspects punched the victim, knocked him to the ground, and removed his wallet. The suspects fled on foot.
