## ACTION ITEMS:

1. Minutes of April 25, 2018, Worksession.

Action: <u>Approved</u>, (ESR/KF, 4-0).

2. A-6554, Petition of Ben Porto and Son, Ltd. (Administrative Appeal). Letter to the Board from Jon D. Pels, Esquire, indicating that pursuant to Expedited Bill No. 1-18, jurisdiction over Water Quality Protection Charge appeals has been transferred to the Director of Finance and the Maryland Tax Court. Accordingly, the Appellant requests withdrawal of this appeal and a refund of the filing fee.

Action: Dismissed as withdrawn and granted refund of filing fee, (KF/ESR, 4-0).

3. S-155, Petition of Montgomery Square – Copenhaver Swim Club, Rebecca Mancuso, and Brian Rindos (Community Swimming Pool). Letter to the Board from Nancy P. Regelin, Esquire, requesting that Georgetown Hill Child Care Center, Inc., be added as a co-holder of this special exception, that Ms. Mancuso and Mr. Rindos be removed as co-holders, and that the special exception be modified as described in Ms. Regelin's letter. Also included is a copy of a letter dated April 26, 2018, sent to neighbors and other parties to this case, informing them of the modification request.

Action: <u>Re-opened the record, substituted co-holders, granted the administrative</u> modification, and waived payment of lower fee, (SBB/ESR, 4-0).

4. S-1464 and S-1465, Petition of Maplewood House Place Limited Partnership, Maplewood Park Place Cooperative Housing Corporation, and Maplewood Park Place Retirement Services, Inc. (Housing for the Elderly and Nursing Home). Letter to the Board from Allison L. Hardy, AIA, requesting an administrative modification. [Large Exhibits: East and West elevations of the East Building; details of the construction and elevations].

Action: <u>Granted the administrative modification of this special exception, (KF/SBB, 4-0).</u>

5. S-2530, Petition of Gabriel Kengni (Accessory Apartment). Letter to the Board from the Petitioner, indicating that the accessory apartment has been eliminated, and requesting that the special exception be revoked and the show cause hearing be dismissed.
