Dear Ms. Talley:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the results from the Full Monitoring conducted August 5-6, 2015, at your Residential Reentry Center (RRC) in Rockville, MD. The monitoring was conducted by Carolyn Dunson and Phelicia Taplin, Residential Reentry Contract Oversight Specialists and me from the Baltimore RRM Office.

During the monitoring, Ms. Dunson, Ms. Taplin and I reviewed accountability procedures, the resident employment program, case management programs, counseling notes, drug testing procedures, community relations, life safety, and facility sanitation. Montgomery County is 100% compliance with all of the applicable Prison Rape Elimination Act community corrections standards as of April 27, 2015. Social climate interviews were conducted with several federal residents. Residents also completed food service surveys; with most stating they receive average and above average meals.

The previous Interim Monitoring was conducted March 25-26, 2015, which resulted in no deficient findings. There were no deficient findings noted by Ms. Dunson during the current monitoring. However, two advised items were noted. They are discussed in greater detail in the attached pages of this report. The monitoring team recognized two areas of significant strength. The current employment rate is seventy-four (74%) percent. All residents who are eligible work full or part time. In addition, Montgomery Country Pre-Release Center presented two distinguished awards: Employee of the Year to Erica Nelson, Work Release Coordinator and the Hillel Raskas Memorial Annual Employee Service Award to Kenny Sterling, Work Release Coordinator. Furthermore, Karla Rhodes, Accreditation Coordinator was instrumental in gathering the required documentation in completing a successful Full Monitoring within two days.

We would like to acknowledge the excellent work and loyal dedication that Stefan LoBuglio provided to the BOP as well as MCPRC during his tenure. We wish Mr. LoBuglio much success in his future

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endeavors as this was his final day as the Director. It was a real pleasure to extend a warm welcome to the Acting Director, Angela Talley. Ms. Talley has more than 20 years of correctional experience and we look forward to continuing our great partnership.

I would like to thank you and your staff for the cooperation our staff received throughout the course of this monitoring. Accordingly, the Full Monitoring conducted on August 5-6, 2015, the advised item in Programs; failed to conduct one on-site visit to verify employment requires a response within thirty days of receipt of this letter.
