SUBJECT: **WORKSESSION: FY11 Operating Budget
Prisoner Medical Services NDA**

For FY11, the County Executive is recommending \$10,000 in funding for this NDA. This NDA provides reimbursements for medical costs incurred by persons under arrest but not under the custody of the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation. The Department of Police administers this NDA. The spending history for this NDA is:

The costs for this responsibility are unpredictable. In FY06, only \$647 was spent. For FY07, over \$47,000 was spent. In FY10, to date, \$97,410 has been spent. The County will have to provide for whatever costs are incurred no matter how much is in the initial budget of this NDA. While FY09 and FY10 have exceeded the appropriation, a majority of the last ten years has been below this amount. **Council staff recommends approval of \$10,000, as recommended by the Executive.**

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
