SUBJECT: **Worksession 2:** Bill 12-16, Human Rights and Civil Liberties – County Minimum Wage – Amount - Annual Adjustment

Bill 12-16, Human Rights and Civil Liberties – County Minimum Wage – Annual Adjustment, sponsored by Lead Sponsor Councilmember Elrich, and Co-Sponsors Councilmembers Leventhal, Riemer, Navarro and Hucker, was introduced on April 12. A public hearing on the Bill was held on June 21.

## Bill 12-16 would:

- increase the County minimum wage by a certain amount;
- require the Chief Administrative Officer to adjust the County minimum wage rate each year; and
- generally amend the laws governing the minimum wage.

## Continuation of Discussion from July 11 HHS Committee Worksession
