AGRICULTURAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Created -- Council Resolution No. 8-705 (1976)
- Purpose -- To advise the County Executive and the County Council on all matters affecting agriculture in Montgomery County.
- Membership -- 15 members. Twelve members shall be bona fide farmers selected so as to be representative of the total farm community and three members shall have no direct financial interest in farming. At least one farm economist and one conservationist shall be included in the committee membership.
- Financial Disclosure -- Not required.
- Terms -- Farmer representatives serve three year terms. Non-farmer representatives serve one year terms. No compensation.
- Meetings -- Third Tuesday of each month. Jeremy Criss, Planning Specialist, Farmland Preservation, Department of Economic Development, Agricultural Activity Center, 18410 Muncaster Road, Derwood, MD 20855. Ph: 301-590-2830; FAX 301-590-2828




