RUSTIC ROADS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Created -- Montgomery County Code, Sec. 49-80 (1993)
- Purpose -- To promote public awareness and knowledge of the rustic roads program in the County; review and comment on classification of rustic roads and exceptional rustic roads; review and comment on Executive Regulations and other County policies and programs that may affect the program; and report bi-annually to the County Executive, the County Council and the Planning Board on the status of the rustic roads program.
- Membership -- The Committee has seven voting members. **Each member must be a resident of the County.** The County Executive should appoint three members who are owner-operators of commercial farmland earning 50 percent or more of their income from farming, one of whom is a representative of the Agricultural Advisory Committee; one member who has knowledge of rural preservation techniques through practical experience and training; one member who has knowledge of roadway engineering through practical experience and training; one member who represents civic associations located in the Agricultural Reserve; and one member who represents civic associations in areas located outside the Agricultural Reserve where there are rustic roads. The Chairman of the Planning Board must designate a member of the Planning Staff as a non-voting member.
- Financial Disclosure - Not required.
- Terms -- Three years.
- Meetings -- Meetings are usually held the 2nd Thursday of each month from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.





Leggett Seeks Applicants for Rustic Roads Advisory Committee

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill three vacancies on the County's Rustic Roads Advisory Committee. One vacancy is for owner-operators of commercial farmland who earn 50% or more of their income from farming. One vacancy is for a representative of a Civic Association outside of the Agricultural Reserve, and one vacancy is for a representative with knowledge of rural preservation techniques through practical experience and training. Two incumbents are eligible to apply for reappointment.

The Rustic Roads Advisory Committee consists of seven voting members who must all be Montgomery County residents. Members serve three-year terms without compensation. The committee meets at least six times a year; usually the second Thursday evening of each month at 7 p.m. in the Executive Office Building in Rockville. Its duties include promoting public awareness of the Rustic Roads Program, reviewing and commenting on the classification of rustic roads, and reviewing and commenting on executive regulations and policies that may affect the program.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by December 23 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville MD 20850 or send an e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A brief resume, including home and work phone numbers, should be enclosed.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
