LEGISLATIVE REQUEST REPORT

Bill 26-09, *Domestic Violence Coordinating Council – Membership*

DESCRIPTION: Bill 26-09 would alter the membership on the Domestic Violence Coordinating Council, and generally amend the law establishing the Domestic Violence Coordinating Council.

PROBLEM: Although the Coordinating Council has efforts aimed at youth, there is no formal link between the Council and the Montgomery County Public Schools. Adding a member from the Board of Education to the Council would benefit both entities.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: To provide a formal connection between the Coordinating Council and the school system.

COORDINATION: Maryland District Court, Montgomery County Circuit Court, State's Attorney for Montgomery County, County Sheriff, Department of Police, Department of Health and Human Services, Commission for Women, Department of Correction and Rehabilitation, Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correction, and Montgomery County Board of Education.
