

COMMISSION ON AGING

- Created -- Montgomery County Code Section 27-35
- Purpose -- Be concerned with educational, health and welfare, employment, recreation and social issues, housing, legislation and other programs and projects that relate to the aging; advocate for local, state and federal programs or services that can benefit the elderly.
- Membership -- No less than 18. **Members must be county residents**; a majority shall be senior citizens. Membership shall include individuals who are or who have been active in business, industry, labor, community service, religion, welfare, and/or education, the professions and representatives of major organizations or agencies significantly concerned with the problems of aging.
- Terms -- Three year terms - no compensation. Members must not serve more than two consecutive terms.
- Meetings -- Fourth Thursday of each month.




#### Leggett Seeks Applicants for Commission on Aging

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill seven vacancies on the Montgomery County Commission on Aging. Five incumbents are eligible to apply for reappointment. Applicants must be county residents, and seniors and non-seniors are encouraged to apply.

Serving as an advocate for the welfare of the County's elderly, the Commission advises the County Executive, the County Council and various Montgomery County Departments on the needs of seniors. Members serve three-year terms without compensation. Meetings are held the fourth Thursday of each month at 401 Hungerford Drive in Rockville from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Commission members are expected to serve on a committee of the Commission as well. Each committee meets on the average of once a month, generally during the day.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by November 21 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850 or send an e-mail to [countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov](mailto:countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov). A brief resume including home and work phone numbers should be enclosed.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Commission are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
