- Membership -- 26 members - approximately one-half of the members will be selected from ethnic groups and one-half from the business and education communities in the County.
- Financial Disclosure -- Not required.
- Terms -- Three year terms - No compensation.
- Meetings -- 1st Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. in Rockville.






County Executive Isiah Leggett is accepting applications for four vacancies on the Committee for Ethnic Affairs.

Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of these selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.


