**ENERGY AND AIR QUALITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Created -- Montgomery County Code Section 18-A-5, as amended 1995

Purpose -- To advise the County Executive and the County Council on preparation, review and implementation of the energy conservation plan; develop recommendations to promote energy consciousness throughout the community; and encourage voluntary participation in energy conservation efforts.

Membership -- Fifteen members. Chair is designated by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. Members must be citizens of the County who are technically knowledgeable and interested in energy and air quality.

Financial Disclosure -- Not required.

Terms -- Three year terms - no compensation.

Meetings -- First Wednesday evening of each month.



**Leggett Seeks Applicants for Energy and Air Quality Advisory Committee**

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill five vacancies on the Energy and Air Quality Advisory Committee. The incumbents are eligible and are expected to apply for reappointment. Individuals with either an air quality or energy background are encouraged to apply. Applicants must be Montgomery County residents.

The committee is particularly interested in scientists, engineers and environmental health specialists with professional experience, education and knowledge of air quality, emissions modeling or energy efficient technologies.

The 15-member committee advises the County Executive and County Council on the development, promotion and implementation of programs to heighten energy awareness, increase energy efficiency and improve indoor and outdoor air quality. Members serve three year terms without compensation. Meetings are held in the evening on the first Wednesday of each month in Rockville.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by June 26 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe St., Rockville, MD 20850 or send an e-mail to CountyExecutive.Boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Applicants should include a brief resume with home and work telephone numbers.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
