

Leggett Seeks Applicants for Workforce Investment Board

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill five vacancies on the Montgomery County Workforce Investment Board. The vacancies are for four business representatives, and one community-based organization representative. Two incumbents are eligible to apply for reappointment.

The Workforce Investment Board advises the County Executive on the administration of the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and oversees workforce development programs and services serving nearly 12,000 residents per year.

The Workforce Investment Board is composed of 30 members. Sixteen members are representatives of businesses who are business owners, chief executives, or other business executives or employers with optimal policymaking or hiring authority, and represent businesses with a workforce that reflects employment opportunities in Montgomery County; three members represent community-based organizations, including those that provide services to people with disabilities and other human service organizations; and two members who are representatives of organized labor. Other members include a representative of Montgomery County Public Schools, Montgomery College, a four-year educational institution of higher learning; Maryland Division of Rehabilitation Services, the Housing Opportunities Commission, Department of Health and Human Services, the Maryland and Montgomery County Departments of Economic Development; an agency administering Title V of the Older Americans Act, and the Maryland Job Service.

Members serve three-year terms without compensation. Meetings are held the third Wednesday morning of every other month. Members are expected to serve on at least one committee or work group that meets approximately once every month.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by May 29 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850 or send an e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A brief resume, including home and work telephone numbers and e-mail address, should be enclosed detailing pertinent experience and business, civic or community group association. Applicants should indicate the type of slot for which they are applying.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Commission are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
