CABLE COMPLIANCE COMMISSION

Created: Bill No. 28-02, Effective 3/6/2003

Purpose: Adjudicates subscriber complaints which have not been resolved by the County Cable Administrator concerning customer cable service or any other product or service that uses any facility or equipment constructed, installed, maintained, operated, or occupying the public rights-of-way under the County's franchise agreement, such as one-way or interactive video, audio, data (including data modem), and information services.

Membership: 5 voting members appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. The Commission should include:

- (1) a cable television service subscriber;
- (2) a broadband Internet service subscriber;
- (3) an individual with general business experience;
- (4) an individual with technical experience in communications.

Financial

Disclosure: Each member must file a limited public financial disclosure statement regarding any communication-related activities and interests and a full confidential financial disclosure statement.

Terms: 3 years (The County Executive must designate the initial term of 2 members as two years; any later term of these 2 members, and the terms of All other members must be 3 years.)

Meetings: Third Wednesday of each month at 4:00 p.m. in Rockville.





Leggett Seeks Applicants for Cable Compliance Commission

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill two vacancies on the Cable Compliance Commission. Applicants should be one of the following: a cable television service subscriber; a broadband internet service subscriber; an individual with general business experience; or and an individual with technical experience in communications.

The Commission must decide subscriber complaints which have not been resolved by the County Cable Administrator concerning customer cable service or any other product or service that uses any facility or equipment constructed, installed, maintained, operated, or occupying the public rights-of-way under the County's franchise agreements, such as one-way or interactive video, audio, data (including cable modem), and information services.

Members serve three year terms without compensation. Meetings are held in Rockville on the third Wednesday of each month at 4:00 p.m. All applicants are required to file a limited public financial disclosure statement regarding any communication-related activities and interests within 15 days of confirmation by Council and annually thereafter.

Applications should write by February 22, to County Executive Isiah Leggett, at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850 or by e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A letter of interest and brief resume with home and work telephone numbers should be enclosed. Members of County boards, committees, and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time.

Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
