B/C/C Name -- **ETHICS COMMISSION**

Created -- Montgomery County Code Section 19A-5.

Purpose -- Responsible for rendering advice on the County's Code of Ethics, and for acting on requests for waivers from ethics prohibitions and outside employment. The Commission also investigates complaints.

Membership -- Five members - Not more than three members may be of the same political party. Members must file annual financial disclosure statements.

Financial Disclosure -- Public financial disclosure required. Statement must be filed before the Council confirms the appointment.

Terms -- Four year terms - no compensation

Meetings -- Usually the first Wednesday of the month.





Leggett Seeks Applicants for Ethics Commission

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill two vacancies on the Montgomery County Ethics Commission. There are five members on the Commission; no more than three members may be from the same political party. The current vacancies may be filled by a Democrat, Republican or Independent. The incumbent members, a Democrat and an Independent, are eligible and intend to apply for reappointment.

Members must reside in the County and be registered to vote in the County. During the member's term of office, he/she must not hold or be a candidate for any state, county or local elected or appointed office. The member must not be an employee of the state, a political subdivision of the state, or a public body created by the state or a political subdivision of the state. The member may not be an employee or officer of a political party; a member must not participate (except by voting or contributing money) in any state, county or local political campaign. The member must not participate (except by voting or contributing money) in support of or opposition to any question placed on the ballot by state, county, or local government, except on a question that directly affects the Commission. The member may not be a lobbyist who lobbies a county agency.

The Ethics Commission is responsible for rendering advice on the County's Code of Ethics; reviewing and approving outside employment requests for county employees; granting waivers from the ethics law as appropriate; and investigating and adjudicating complaints.

Members serve four-year terms without compensation and usually meet one evening per month in Rockville. There are also occasional additional meetings as necessary. **Members are required to file public financial disclosure statements before the Council confirms appointment and each annual period thereafter.**

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply. An application, consisting of a **brief cover letter and resume**, should be sent by mail to County Executive Isiah Leggett, 101 Monroe Street, 2nd Floor, Rockville, MD 20850, or by email to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Home and employment addresses, as well as contact phone numbers and email addresses should be included. If appropriate, applicants should indicate the position for which they are applying. The deadline for application is **August 28**.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such

group at a time. Members of this Commission are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Mr. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
