Leggett Seeks Applicants for Mid-County Citizens Advisory Board

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill seven vacancies on the Mid-County Citizens Advisory Board. The incumbents are eligible to apply for reappointment.

The Board is comprised of 15 residents and business from the following areas: Upper Rock Creek, Wheaton, Kensington, Kemp Mill, Aspen Hill, Glenmont, Norbeck, Forest Glen, Olney, Brookeville, and Sandy Spring. Members serve three-year terms without compensation. Meetings are usually held the third Tuesday evening of each month at the Mid-County Services Center, 2424 Reddie Drive, Wheaton.

The Board serves as a liaison between the community, the County Executive, County Council, and County government departments by identifying community concerns and recommending possible solutions. It also advises the Director of the Mid-County Services Center on transportation, economic development, housing, education, human services, environment, recreation, public safety and other issues of importance to the area.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by June 12 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe St., Rockville, MD 20850 or send an e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A brief resume, with work and home phone numbers and e-mail address (if available), should be included.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Board are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
