PEDESTRIAN AND TRAFFIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Created: County Council Resolution No. 14-1281 (as amended 10/11/05), and County Council Resolution No. 16-192 (adopted 6/19/07) extending the Committee and amending Montgomery County Code Sec. 49-81.

Purpose: Advise the County Executive and County Council on the implementation of the County Executive's Pedestrian Safety Initiative, and the status of the recommendations of the original Pedestrian Safety Task Force's Final Report involving education, enforcement, engineering and legislative actions; provide advice to elected officials regarding priorities and needs in the area of pedestrian and bicycle safety and access, and other pedestrian-related issues; and identify any new issues that may emerge. The Committee will report on its activities annually to the County Executive and County Council by November 1, 2002 and November 1 each year thereafter.

Membership: 17 members appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. One representative each from the following: Police; Public Works and Transportation; Montgomery County Public Schools ; MC Park and Planning Commission; a representative from one of the five regional services centers; Maryland Municipal League; County Council (if the Council recommends one); State Highway Administration; and nine members of the Public-at-Large representing different areas of the County, including one bicycle advocate.

Officers: The County Executive must designate a member of the Committee to be Chair. The Chair will be appointed for one two-year term.

Financial

Disclosure: Not required.

Terms: Three-years - The term of the Committee originally ended at the expiration of 5 years (7/2007), but was extended until 7/2012.

Meetings: Every other month, first Thursday of the month, including January, March, May, July, Sept. and Nov. from 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM. at the Rockville EOB and various locations throughout the County.





Leggett Seeks Applicants for Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory Committee

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill one public member vacancy on the Montgomery County Pedestrian and Traffic Safety Advisory Committee. Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply.

The 17-member Advisory Committee includes six government representatives, one public school representative, one Maryland Municipal League representative, and nine general public members who represent various regions of Montgomery County, including one representative of the bicycle advocacy community.

This Committee provides advice to the County Executive, County Council, and elected officials on implementation of the County's Pedestrian Safety Initiative, priorities and needs in the area of pedestrian and bicycle safety and access, gathers information on pedestrian and bicycle safety, and identifies any new issues that may emerge. To review the work the committee is involved with, visit the County's Pedestrian Safety Website at: www.montgomerycountymd.gov/walk.

Members serve without compensation. Meetings generally are held every other month on weekday evenings. All members are also expected to serve on various sub-committees, and these meetings will be held as needed. The Committee, initially established in 2002 with original duration of five years, was granted an extension through July 2012.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply. An application, consisting of a **brief cover letter and resume**, should be sent by mail to County Executive Isiah Leggett, 101 Monroe Street, 2nd Floor, Rockville, MD 20850, or by email to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Home and employment addresses, as well as contact phone numbers and email addresses should be included. If appropriate, applicants should indicate the position for which they are applying. The deadline for application is **August 7**.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are

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made public as part of the confirmation process.

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
