

SILVER SPRING TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Created -- Montgomery County Code, Section 42A-10.
- Purpose -- The Committee may advise the County government on all aspects of programs, management and finances relating to the implementation of transportation system management in the Silver Spring Central Business District and vicinity. The Committee also proposes guidelines for traffic mitigation plans; monitors the implementation of the traffic mitigation plans; evaluates progress in attaining the commuting goals specified in the Annual Growth Policy for Silver Spring; recommends government, private or joint actions necessary to facilitate attainment of the commuting goals specified in the Annual Growth Policy; advises the Director of DOT on parking policies, including any relevant issues relating to neighborhood parking and pedestrian access and safety; and, submits comments and recommendations on the Director's Annual Report by December 1 of each year.
- Membership -- 12 voting members and 4 non-voting members. Three members are nominated by the Silver Spring Chamber of Commerce; three members are nominated by the Silver Spring Advisory Board of which: one is a resident of the transportation management district established in the Silver Spring Central Business District; one is a resident within the North and Western Silver Spring Sector Plan areas; and, one is a resident of the southern portion of the Kemp Mill-Four Corners or the Silver Spring East master plan area, or the Montgomery County portion of the Takoma Park planning area. Three members are employers of fewer than 50 employees and three members are employers of 50 or more employees in the Central Business District. Non-voting members are the Directors or the designees of the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Silver Spring Center; a representative of the Planning Board; and, a representative of the Montgomery County Police Department.

- Terms -- Three year terms - no compensation
- Meetings -- Second Thursday of each month at 8 a.m.



Leggett Seeks Applicants for Silver Spring Transportation Management District Advisory Committee

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill two vacancies on the Silver Spring Transportation Management District (SSTMD) Advisory Committee. The vacancies are for one large business representative (employer of 50 or more employees), and one small business representative (employer of fewer than 50 employees) in the Silver Spring central business district.

The advisory committee advises the County on all aspects of operations of the SSTMD. It monitors employer traffic mitigation plans, proposes guidelines for lessening traffic, reviews traffic patterns and makes recommendations on commuting, parking and other related matters. The committee consists of 12 voting members (including three residents nominated by the Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board) and four non-voting members who represent the County's Department of Transportation, Department of Police, the Planning Board and the Silver Spring Regional Center.

Members serve three-year terms without compensation, meeting the second Thursday of the month at 8:00 a.m. in downtown Silver Spring. Additional meetings may be held as necessary. For more information go to www.montgomerycountymd.gov/commute and click on "TMDs."

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply. An application, consisting of a **brief cover letter and resume**, should be sent by mail to County Executive Isiah Leggett, 101 Monroe Street, 2nd Floor, Rockville, MD 20850, or by email to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Home and employment addresses, as well as contact phone numbers and email addresses should be included. If appropriate, applicants should indicate the position for which they are applying. The deadline for application is **August 7**.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
