

BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR BUILDING CONTRACTORS

- Created -- Montgomery County Code Section 31C-4
- Purpose -- To certify to the Executive Director of the Office of Consumer Affairs whether the applicant and the organization of the applicant are qualified to comply with the building code and laws of the County and State and to fully perform building contracts and that the applicant should be licensed.
- Membership -- Five members - no more than two members must be active in the residential construction field at the time of their appointment.
- Financial Disclosure -- Confidential disclosure required.
- Terms -- Three year terms - no compensation
- Meetings -- First Tuesday of each month at 8:30 a.m.
- Staff -- Ralph Vines, 240-777-3774, DHCA, Division of Consumer Affairs, 100 Maryland Avenue, 3rd Floor, Rockville.





Leggett Seeks Applicants for Board of Registration for Building Contractors

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill one vacancy on the Board of Registration for Building Contractors. The vacancy is for a builder representative who must be active in the residential construction field.

The five-member Board provides for the licensing of residential building contractors. The Board holds hearings and can revoke, suspend or deny licenses. Members serve three-year terms without compensation. Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month at 8:30 a.m. in Rockville. Members are required to file a confidential financial statement within 15 days of council confirmation and each annual period thereafter.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply. An application, consisting of a brief cover letter and resume, should be sent by mail to County Executive Isiah Leggett, 101 Monroe Street, 2nd Floor, Rockville, MD 20850, or by email to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Home and employment addresses, as well as contact phone numbers and email addresses should be included. If appropriate, applicants should indicate the position for which they are applying. The deadline for application is **September 11**.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this Board are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
