VICTIM SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD
(formerly known as the Advisory Board on Victims and their Families)

- Created -- Montgomery County Code - Art. VII - Sec. 24-54 through 24-60.
- Purpose -- The Board must periodically review available services and facilities for victims and their families; determine needs of the victim and family services program; submit at least one report annually to the County Executive and County Council on the progress of programs to victims and their families and of actions needed to improve those programs; make recommendations for appropriate allocation of funds in accordance with agreed upon priorities and consideration of financial resources. The Board also assists the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services in the development of the annual victim services and families plan and acts as a local advocate for victim services programming.
- Membership -- 19 voting members who are residents of Montgomery County and 4 non-voting ex-officio members. The voting members consist of five from among the mental health, legal, medical, dental and nursing professions; ten may be members of the listed professions but represent the community as a whole; one may be a member of the clergy.
- Four non-voting ex officio members shall be the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services and representatives from the State's Attorney's Office, Public Defender's Office; and the Department of Police.
- Financial Disclosure - Not required.
- Terms -- Three year terms.
- Meetings -- Fourth Thursday evening of each month, 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.



Leggett Seeks Applicants for Victim Services Advisory Board

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill seven vacancies on the Victim Services Advisory Board. Two vacancies are for professional representatives from the mental health, legal, medical, dental and nursing professions. One vacancy is for a member of the clergy. Four vacancies are for public-at-large members. All members must be residents of Montgomery County.

The board advises the County Executive, County Council, and the Department of Health and Human Services, Behavioral Health and Crisis Services Division, which assists victims of sexual assault, domestic violence and other crimes. The board consists of 18 voting members. Members serve three-year terms and do not receive compensation.

The primary responsibility of the board is to review available services for crime victims and their families, determine needs and gaps in services for victims and their families, and recommend policy changes in County justice system and human service programs. The Board submits at least one report annually to the County Executive and the County Council on the progress of programs for crime victims and necessary improvements and on other relevant systems and policy issues concerning victims. The board also makes recommendations for appropriate funding allocations based on priorities and available resources, participates in developing an annual victim and family service plan, and acts as a local advocate for crime victim services programming.

The board meets the fourth Thursday evening of each month in Rockville. Also, an average of five hours per month of board-related committee work is expected.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply. An application, consisting of a brief cover letter and resume, should be sent by mail to County Executive Isiah Leggett, 101 Monroe Street, 2nd Floor, Rockville, MD 20850, or by email to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. Home and employment addresses, as well as contact phone numbers and email addresses should be included. If appropriate, applicants should indicate the position for which they are applying. The deadline for application is **September 18**.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this board are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
