SUBJECT: Extension of Time for the Appointment of Acting County Attorney

Background

1. Section 1A-105 (g) of the County Code requires that no one may serve as an acting official for more than 6 months unless the County Council extends the limit for such service.
2. It has been the Council's policy not to extend the appointment of Acting Directors for an indefinite period, but to limit extensions to six months. After six months, the Executive can request an additional extension if necessary.
2. Marc Hansen was named Acting County Attorney on January 19, 2010 and has served since that date.
3. On July 6, 2010 the County Executive requested the County Council to extend the time limit for the Acting County Attorney until a permanent County Attorney is appointed and confirmed.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The time limit of the appointment of the Acting County Attorney, Marc Hansen, is extended until a permanent County Attorney has been confirmed by the Council, but no later than January 19, 2011.
