## **COUNCILMEMBER HOWARD DENIS NAMES KEN HARTMAN AS TOP AIDE**

Councilmember Howard Denis, who represents Bethesda, Chevy Chase, Friendship Heights, Potomac and Garrett Park, today named Ken Hartman as his confidential aide.

Hartman replaces Tedi Osias, who is leaving for a fellowship at Harvard's John F. Kennedy School of Government in Boston.

Hartman, who lives in Bethesda, previously worked as the County Council legislative analyst responsible for housing, community development, consumer affairs, procurement, and cable TV. From 1993 to 1997, he worked as a senior legislative aide to Councilmember Betty Ann Krahnke and later worked as the Project Implementation Coordinator for the city of Rockville.

Hartman is a graduate of the University of Maryland at College Park, with a degree in government and politics and is working towards a Masters of Public Administration at Virginia Polytechnic and State University.
