ANDREWS TO REVEAL PREVIOUSLY UNDISCLOSED DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS TO PROMINENT PRO-ICC POLITICIANS

Councilmember Phil Andrews will hold a **news conference Tuesday** to release previously undisclosed information about large campaign contributions made by developers to prominent state and local public officials who are pushing the \$3 billion InterCounty Connector.

Andrews is the former Maryland director of Common Cause and a champion of stronger campaign finance legislation.

In addition to the immense environmental damage that would be done by the superhighway – and no traffic relief by the ICC for Beltway and I-270 commuters in Montgomery County according to the State's own figures – the superhighway would increase development along its route.

The news conference comes on the same day that the Council discusses and takes action on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the ICC in a session starting at 1:30 PM.
