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**AN EXPEDITED ACT** to:

- (1) expand the property tax credit for military retirees to include a retired member of the uniformed services, the military reserves, or the national guard; and
- (2) generally amend the law relating to property tax credits.

By amending

Montgomery County Code  
Chapter 52, Taxation  
Section 52-110, Property tax credit – elderly individuals and veterans


- 7                       (2)   (A)   the individual is at least 65 years old;
- 8                                       (B)   the individual is a retired member of the uniformed services
- 9   of the United States [armed forces] as defined in 10 U.S.C.
- 10    §101, the military reserves, or the national guard; and
- 11                       (C)   the dwelling for which a property tax credit is sought has a
- 12    maximum assessed value of \$500,000 at the time the
- 13    individual first applied for the credit.


