**SUBJECT:** Action to Extend Effective Date for Temporary Executive Regulation 8-08T  
Advertisements Subject to Property Tax Disclosure Requirements

**Background**


1. On April 1, 2008, the County Council received Temporary Executive Regulation 8-08T, Advertisements Subject to Property Tax Disclosure Requirements, Office of Consumer Protection. This Temporary Executive Regulation was published in the Montgomery County Register on April 1, 2008
2. A Temporary Executive Regulation is effective when the County Council receives a copy from the issuer with an explanation why its immediate adoption is necessary. A Temporary Regulation is effective for not more than 90 days. Temporary Executive Regulation 8-08T will expire on June 30, 2008.
3. The issuer may ask the Council to extend the effective period for up to an additional 90 days and must provide a compelling reason for an extension. The Council must not extend a Temporary Executive Regulation more than once.
4. On June 23, 2008, the Council received a request from the County Executive to extend Temporary Executive Regulation 8-08T for an additional 90 days.

**Action**

*The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following resolution:*

The effective date for Temporary Executive Regulation 8-08T, Advertisements Subject to Property Tax Disclosure Requirements, is extended to September 28, 2008.
