SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Council Action on Resolutions Due to Expire on August 31, 2008

Background

1. Rule 7(e) of the Council's Rules of Procedure requires that a resolution will expire on the next August 31 after it is introduced, unless the Council adopts or defeats it sooner or by motion extends it to a specified date.
2. Resolutions introduced since September 2007, but not yet adopted, defeated, or extended will expire on August 31, 2008 if not extended.

Action


The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The expiration date of the following resolutions is extended to August 31, 2009:

- Resolution to approve amendment to Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan: Solid Waste Collection Subdistricts;
- Resolution to terminate the Clarksburg Town Center Development District;
- Resolution to set certain penalty and fee amounts under the Forest Conservation Law;

- Resolution to adopt Board of Health Regulation requiring certain eating and drinking establishments to post certain nutrition information on menu boards and menus;
- Any resolution scheduled for action on July 29, 2008 that is deferred until a later date; and
- Any resolutions introduced on July 29, 2008 on which the Council will not act before August 31, 2008.
