SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Council Action on Resolutions Due to Expire on August 31, 2011

Background

1. Rule 7(e) of the Council's Rules of Procedure requires that a resolution will expire on the next August 31 after it is introduced, unless the Council adopts or defeats it sooner or by motion extends it to a specified date.
2. Resolutions introduced since September 2010, but not yet adopted, defeated, or extended will expire on August 31, 2011 if not extended.


Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The expiration dates of the following resolutions are extended to August 31, 2012:

- 1) Resolution to adopt Board of Health Regulation requiring a health impact assessment for major road projects, sponsored by Councilmembers Trachtenberg, Elrich, Andrews, Navarro and Ervin. It was introduced on September 29, 2009 and a public hearing was conducted on November 17, 2009;
- 2) Resolution to adopt Subdivision Staging Policy Amendment (SSP 11-02) - Day Care Centers, sponsored by Councilmember Floreen. It was introduced on May 26, 2011 and a public hearing was held on July 12, 2011;
- 3) Any resolution scheduled for action on July 26, 2011 that is deferred until a later date; and
- 4) Any resolutions introduced on July 26, 2011 on which the Council will not act before August 31, 2011.
