SUBJECT: Extension of Temporary Executive Regulation 18-13T, School Bus Safety Cameras

Background

- 1. The Council received Temporary Executive Regulation 18-13T, *School Bus Safety Cameras*, on November 25, 2013, with an effective date of January 1, 2014, and it will expire on April 1, 2014.
- 2. County Code section 2A-15(j) establishes the procedures for issuing and extending a temporary regulation. Among other things, the section says that: a temporary regulation may be issued for a period of up to 90 days; the issuer may ask the Council once to extend the effective period for an additional 90 days; the issuer must provide a compelling reason for the extension; the Council must not extend a temporary regulation more than once.
- 3. The Executive has requested an extension of Temporary Regulation 18-13T to enable the Police Department to continue the development and adoption process for a permanent regulation to supersede the temporary one.

<u>Action</u>

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The effective period for Temporary Executive Regulation 18-13T *School Bus Safety Cameras*, is extended until June 30, 2014.
