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**SUBJECT:** Amendment to Resolution 17-1111, Approval and Appropriation for the FY 2015 Operating Budget of the Montgomery County Government, Budget Provision 42(b), Emergency Medical Services Transport Insurance Reimbursement Program

**Background**

1. On May 22, 2014 the County Council approved Resolution 17-1111, Approval and Appropriation for the FY 2015 Operating Budget of the Montgomery County Government. Budget Provision 42 provides the required procedures for allocating the portion of the Emergency Medical Services Transport (EMST) Insurance Reimbursement Program revenue (after deducting the cost of implementation) for the benefit of local fire and rescue departments (LFRDs).
2. Budget Provision 42(b) erroneously requires that by October 15, 2014, Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Services (MCFRS) must distribute to LFRDs 15% of the actual amount of revenue received in the restricted EMST Reimbursement account attributable to FY 2013 (after deducting EMST Reimbursement Program implementation costs), as calculated by the Department of Finance. The correct time for calculating the revenue should be from January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014.


**Action**

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following action:

The Council amends Resolution 17-1111, Budget Provision 42(b) to read:

By October 15, 2014, MCFRS must distribute to LFRDs 15% of the actual amount of revenue received in the restricted EMST Reimbursement account from January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014 (after deducting EMST Reimbursement Program implementation costs), as calculated by the Department of Finance.
