SUBJECT: Amendment to Fiscal Year 2015 Operating Budget
Resolution 17-1111, Section G, Fiscal Year 2015 Designation of Entities for
Non-Competitive Contract Award Status – Siemens Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc.

Background

1. Section 11B-14(a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that “a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and a proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council.” The result of this action is to amend the FY 2015 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the agency listed below.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contracts with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
3. The Department of Health and Human Services will fund the contract with the Provider listed from existing appropriations for FY 2015.
4. The Department of Health and Human Services will amend its existing contract with the Siemens Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc. for provision of services as stated in the amended FY 2015 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following action:

The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 17-1111, Section G, FY 2015, Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that this additional funding for this vendor serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY 2015 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to:

Modify the description of services for Siemens Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc., to reflect the current program description. The description of services should read: "Provides drug test kits, drug testing chemicals/reagents, all related supplies as well as equipment required to administer tests and software as needed. Contract also provides training of County staff on use and daily maintenance of equipment."
