SUBJECT: Amendments to Fiscal Year 2016 Operating Budget
Resolution 18-150, Section G, Fiscal Year 2016 Designation of Entities for
Non-Competitive Contract Award Status – WorkSource Montgomery, Inc.

Background

1. Section 11B-14(a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that “a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and a proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council.” The result of this action is to amend the FY 2016 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to for the entities listed below.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contracts with these entities serves a public purpose and that such expenses would be in the public interest.
3. The Department of Health and Human Services will fund a contract with WorkSource Montgomery, Inc. from existing FY 2016 appropriations.
4. The Department of Health and Human Services will develop a new contract with WorkSource Montgomery, Inc. for provision of services as stated in the amended FY16 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.

Action


The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following action:

The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 18-150, Section G, FY 2016, Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that amending the contract for this vendor serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY 2016 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to include:

1. A new contract with WorkSource Montgomery, Inc. in the amount of \$243,518 to “provide workforce development services tailored to internationally-trained health professionals, including cost for operating staff, and support services such as guidance and support related to credential evaluation, licensing or certification processes.”
