SUBJECT: Resolution to Extend Time for Council action on Executive Regulation 5-16, Contracts and Procurement – Health Insurance Preference (Department of Health and Human Services)

Background

1. On July 19, 2016, the County Council received Executive Regulation 5-16, *Contracts and Procurement – Health Insurance Preference*.
2. This regulation would implement Bill 5-15, *Contracts and Procurement - Health Insurance Preference*. Bill 5-15, enacted on September 15, 2015, created a preference in the procurement of services by the County for a small business that provides health insurance for its employees.
3. The Council must review the regulation under Method (2) of Section 2A-15 of the County Code.
4. Under Method (2), if the Council does not approve or disapprove a regulation with 60 calendar days after the Council receives the regulation, the regulation automatically takes effect.
5. Code Section 2A-15 authorizes the Council to extend the deadline for action on a regulation under Method (2).

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The time for consideration of Executive Regulation 5-16, *Contracts and Procurement – Health Insurance Preference*, is extended to December 31, 2016.
