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**SUBJECT:** Amendment to Fiscal Year 2017 Operating Budget  
Resolution 18-506, Section G, Fiscal Year 2017 Designation of Entities for  
Non-Competitive Contract Award Status – WorkSource Montgomery,  
Community Ministries of Rockville, YMCA of Metropolitan Washington, Inc.,  
Montgomery County Language Minority Health Project, Inc. (Proyecto Salud),  
Mercy Health Clinic

**Background**

1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that “a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council.” The result of this action is to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the agencies listed below.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contracts with these entities serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
3. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and Office of the County Executive will fund contracts with Providers listed below from existing appropriations for FY 2017.
4. The DHHS will correct the purposes for existing contracts with Community Ministries of Rockville, Inc., YMCA of Metropolitan Washington, Inc., Montgomery County Language Minority Health Project, Inc. (Proyecto Salud), and Mercy Health Clinic, Inc. The Office of the County Executive will amend its existing contract with WorkSource Montgomery, Inc. for provision of services as stated in the amended FY 2017 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.

**Action**

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following action:

The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 18-506, Section G, FY 2017 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has recommended this action and stated that amending the contract for this vendor serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY 2017 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to:

1. Increase the existing contract with WorkSource Montgomery, Inc. by \$80,000 to \$1,062,344.
2. Correct the purpose for an existing contract with Community Ministries of Rockville, Inc. in the amount of \$58,693 from "Provides for a full time registered nurse to serve as a Referral Coordinator/Patient Navigator" to "Provides partial salary support for patient navigation and specialty care referrals and coordination."
3. Correct the purpose of an existing contract with the YMCA of Metropolitan Washington, Inc. in the amount of \$10,000 from "Provides for operation of after-school and mentoring program for youth and adults through a neighborhood-based community center" to "Provides case management and training for volunteers in an intensive one-on-one mentoring program for court-involved male youth." (DHHS)
4. Correct the purpose of an existing contract with the Montgomery County Language Minority Health Project, Inc. (Proyecto Salud) in the amount of \$43,648 from "Provides for care management of vulnerable individuals with multiple chronic conditions" to "Provides for an effective and efficient process of referrals to pro-bono and charity specialty services to serve low-income, uninsured, underserved patients."
5. Correct the purpose of an existing contract with Mercy Health Clinic, Inc. in the amount of \$50,000 from "Provides for a nurse practitioner to provide primary care to low-income uninsured patients" to "Provides for support for medical staff to provide primary care for low-income, uninsured patients and patients who have Medicaid."
