SUBJECT: Amendment to Fiscal Year 2017 Operating Budget
Resolution 18-506, Section G, Fiscal Year 2017 Designation of Entities for
Non-Competitive Contract Award Status

Background

1. Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that “a contract may be awarded without competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council.” The result of this action is to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the agency listed below.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer has determined that funding for the contract with this entity serves a public purpose and that such an expense would be in the public interest.
3. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will fund the contract with the Provider listed below from existing appropriations for FY17 and the source of funds is State aid.
4. The DHHS will amend the contract with the Primary Care Coalition, Inc., for provision of services as stated in the amended FY17 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following action:


The Council approves an amendment to the Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award and thereby amends Resolution 18-506, Section G, FY17 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award. The Chief Administrative Officer has

recommended this action and stated that amending the contract with this vendor serves a public purpose and is in the public interest.

The FY17 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award Status resolution is amended to:

1. Increase the existing \$552,070 contract with the Primary Care Coalition, Inc., by \$120,000 to \$672,070 to read: "Provides 'one stop' services to sexually and physically abused children and expands mental health and psychological services to include transitional trauma therapy services."
