The Affordable Housing Task Force, established by County Executive Isiah Leggett in March 2007, consists of community members, housing advocates and industry leaders. Its mission is to consider policies and programs for the production and preservation of affordable housing. The task force plans on submitting a final report to the County Executive in January 2008.
