The mission of the DEP is to enhance the quality of life in our community by protecting and improving Montgomery County's air, water, and land in a sustainable way while fostering smart growth, a thriving economy, and healthy communities. The Operating Budget differs from the Capital Improvement Program budget in that it shows the cost of running the county. Major initiatives funded by the proposed budget include: Add two positions to address flooding Countywide. In addition, amend the CIP to create a new Flood Control Study project to investigate sub-watershed-level flooding solutions. Provide funding and positions to implement a Building Energy Performance Standards program to improve energy efficiency and reduce the greenhouse gas emissions from buildings,
