

# Montgomery County Sewer Service Area Category Map June 2003





Water and Sewer Service Area Categories	
Service Area Categories	Category Definition and General Description
W-1 and S-1	Areas served by community systems which are either existing or under construction. - This may include properties or areas for which community (public) system mains are not immediately available or which have not yet connected to existing community service.
W-2 and S-2	<i>Categories W-2 and S-2 are not used in Montgomery County. (State definition: Areas served by extensions of existing community and multi-use systems which are in the final planning stages.)</i>
W-3 and S-3	Areas where improvements to or construction of new community systems will be given immediate priority and service will generally be provided within two years or as development and requests for community service are planned and scheduled.
W-4 and S-4	Areas where improvements to or construction of new community systems will be programmed for the three- through six-year period. - This includes areas generally requiring the approval of CIP projects before service can be provided.
W-5 and S-5	Areas where improvements to or construction of new community systems are planned for the seven- through ten-year period. - This category is frequently used to identify areas where land use plans recommend future service staged beyond the scope of the six-year CIP planning period.
W-6 and S-6	Areas where there is no planned community service either within the ten-year scope of this plan or beyond that time period. This includes all areas not designated as categories 1 through 5. - Category 6 includes areas that are planned or staged for community service beyond the scope of the Water and Sewer Plan's ten-year planning period, and areas that are not ever expected for community service on the basis of adopted plans.
Multi-Use Systems	Properties approved for the use of multi-use (or large-capacity) individual on-site systems, having a treatment capacity of 1,500 or more gallons per day (gpd). Generally, properties approved for multi-use systems are designated as categories W-6 and/or S-6.




**Notes:**

- 1) This map updates the previous June 1999 map and shows service area changes and corrections approved between June 1999 and June 2003, and changes from W-3 to W-1 to reflect the availability of new community water service.
- 2) The service area categories for certain properties depicted on this map carry special service conditions or restrictions specific to those properties. These conditions and restrictions will be shown on a future category map update. In the interim, please refer to the conditions and restrictions depicted on the 1992 map update, or contact DEP staff at 240-777-7780.
- 3) This map represents Montgomery County's official record of water and sewer service area categories as part of the triennial update of the Comprehensive Water Supply and Sewerage Systems Plan.
