**NOTICE OF OUTFALL STABILIZATION PROJECT  
ON ANNAPOLIS ROCK ROAD**

Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you of the upcoming culvert outfall stabilization project in your area to be managed by the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT). The project will take place at the recently completed culvert replacement on Annapolis Rock Road at the creek, near the PEPCO power transmission lines.

The work will be performed under contract by D & F Construction, and will include the installation of rip rap stone to stabilize the culvert stream bed and embankments and minimize erosion. The county right-of-way in front of your residence may be disturbed by the planned project improvements. Any disturbed areas will be restored directly after the storm drain repairs and during construction activities.

The outfall stabilization project is scheduled to start on June 30, 2014 and will take ten (10) to fifteen (15) days to complete, weather permitting. Work hours are from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. We apologize for any inconvenience this project may cause and appreciate your patience during this important construction activity.
