**NOTICE OF INTERRUPTION IN WATER SERVICE
NEWBRIDGE DRIVE**

Dear Resident:

This letter is to provide you with an update on a scheduled temporary water main interruption as it relates to the ongoing culvert replacements on Newbridge Drive. This project is being managed by the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT). The temporary interruption to water service is coordinated through and in conjunction with the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).

The existing 20-inch water line located in the bed of Newbridge Drive requires a vertical and horizontal relocation in order to proceed with the installation of the three (3) new 72-inch concrete drainage culverts. Following the start of construction, the waterline was found to be at a lower elevation than shown on the as-built drawings and in conflict with the top of the new concrete culverts. A design was developed by MCDOT to address this conflict, approved by the WSSC and work to adjust the waterline is now underway. This waterline relocation requires a temporary 8-hour interruption to water service. A second interruption, to re-install the waterline, will occur near the end of the project; in late October. The temporary interruption to water service is well coordinated with the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service as a precautionary measure.

Weather permitting, the WSSC will temporary suspend water service to your home on Wednesday, September 17, between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. During that time, workers will temporarily remove a portion of the 20-inch waterline and cap its ends, clearing the way for culvert installation. Water service will then resume. A total of thirty-seven homes along Newbridge Drive, Hunt Valley Court, Mayberry Court, and Twin Creek Court will be affected by this interruption. For your information, a map of the affected properties is attached to this letter. Again, the interruption is currently planned to occur on Wednesday, September 17, between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

By planning the interruption to water service during the day, we hope to minimize inconveniences to your morning routine and complete the work, thus restoring service, by the time you return home from work, school, or other daytime activities. Additionally, the daytime schedule will provide access to additional parts and materials, should they be needed, that may not have otherwise been available had the temporary shutdown occurred overnight.


