**NOTICE OF NEWBRIDGE DRIVE
PROJECT RESCHEDULING**

Dear Resident:

This letter is to update you of the schedule modification to the emergency drainage improvement project on Newbridge Drive. This project is being managed by the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT). Since late June 2014, the emergency culvert replacement has required a portion of Newbridge Drive be closed at the creek between Mayberry Court and Hunt Valley/Twin Creek Court. During recent construction activities, unanticipated site conditions were observed, which will require coordination with the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) to modify the original work plan. MCDOT is currently working with WSSC to expedite the completion of the revised plan design.

The emergency culvert replacement on Newbridge Drive is now expected to be completed by the end of October, weather permitting. Work hours remain from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. However, the contractor will be permitted to work Saturdays, if necessary, to maintain work schedules and/or expedite the completion of the project. Variable message signs will supply you with road closure information as well as reopening information as the project proceeds; the signs have been placed at the closure points along Newbridge Drive. **Please follow the detour signs for alternative routes.** Road closure and project updates can also be found on our website at: <http://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/dot-highway/index.html>.

We understand this is an urgent matter and we are progressively working together to complete this project as soon as possible with the least amount of inconvenience.
