"Level 4" Injury Severity = The person was recorded as being disabled (Incapacitated) due to the accident.

"Level 5" Injury Severity = The person was recorded to be dead or died due to the accident.

Pedestrian Crash Data Definitions

Collision data cited: The number of incidents of collision between a motor vehicle and a pedestrian(s) as reported to the State through the Maryland Automated Accident Reporting System (MAARS) or Automated Crash Reporting System (ACRS).

- a) Incident in this report refers to the overall collision—it does not reflect the number of pedestrians injured in the collision, e.g., a motor vehicle colliding with two or three pedestrians will only be reported as one incident.
- b) This report does not include bicycle collisions.
- c) This report does not include pedestrian accidents not involving a motor vehicle, e.g., a bicycle colliding with a pedestrian will not be recorded on this report.
- d) This report does not include pedestrian collisions on interstate highways.
- e) This report does not include pedestrian collisions occurring within the City of Takoma Park.

Level of severity of injury:

- 01: Not injured
- 02: Possible injury
- 03: Injured, but not incapacitated
- 04: Disabled/ incapacitated
- 05: Fatal
