Program serves people ages 18 years and older with head injuries and related disabilities. Vocational services include: vocational assessment and program planning; skills development; resume preparation; work adjustment training; work hardening; job development; job coaching; and employer and peer education. Operate full-time residential services for clients and offer respite services for occasional, short-term temporary physical and emotional relief to family caring for adults with neurological impairment. Operate two day treatment programs that address cognitive rehabilitation; academic remediation and training; behavioral skills; communication skills; transportation and travel; community recreation and social skills; money management and budgeting; life skills; health and safety; pre-employment skills; obtaining benefits and social services; and physical and emotional health. Community and individual support is offered to individuals that live in the community. Supports may include budgeting; shopping or accessing stores; meal planning and preparation; scheduling and attending medical appointments; participating in recreational and life enrichment activities; organizing a home or office; attending college or adult-learning opportunities; and obtaining or maintaining benefits such as Social Security, Medical Assistance, Food Stamps, etc.

Brain Injury Clinic: Children who require more extensive interdisciplinary care are evaluated and following in the clinic. **Brain Injury Responsiveness Program:** Evaluates and treats children and adolescents with a history of injury to the brain who exhibit altered arousal and/or altered ability to interact with their environment. Patients are either admitted to the inpatient neurorehabilitation unit or receive intensive outpatient coordinate care.
