Patients are assigned to a student dentist who arranges appointments, provides general dentistry services, and arranges for specialty consultations and treatment. Services for adults include fillings, crowns, bridges, implant restorations, dentures, endodontics (root canals), esthetic dentistry (basic teeth whitening, bonding services, and tooth-colored fillings), periodontics (treatment of gum disease) and oral pathology consultations. Appointments are available Monday, Wednesday and Friday in the morning and afternoon. There is a \$203 fee for the initial examination and necessary diagnostic x-rays. This fee will also cover the cost of your comprehensive work-up appointment and treatment planning appointment in the predoctoral clinic. No other dental treatment will be provided at this screening appointment. Information gathered at the screening appointment will be used to determine which program can best provide your dental care. Comprehensive oral health care services are available for children from infancy through age 18 in their Pediatric Dentistry Clinic in an environment designed especially for children. Services include comprehensive oral evaluation; assessment of risk of tooth decay; teeth cleaning; fluoride treatments; sealants; tooth-colored fillings; space maintainers (to save space for adult teeth); athletic mouth guards; teeth whitening (for adolescents); cosmetic dentistry; and emergency dental care. Appointment times may vary depending on your provider's schedule. Special care is available for persons with disabilities, persons with complex medical problems, and older adults.

General dental care, including preventive, restorative, limited oral surgery and emergency dental services is provided to low income and uninsured/underinsured Montgomery County residents. Patients in need of specialty dental care are given information for alternative dental resources for follow up care. Seniors (age 60 and over), children (age 18 and younger) and pregnant women may enroll in person at one of the Office of Eligibility and Support Services locations listed below. If you are already enrolled in the Senior Program, Maternity Partnership Program or the Care for Kids Program, please call the Dental Clinic closest to your home to schedule an appointment for a dental check up or other services. Hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Clinic offers an extensive range of dental treatments and oral healthcare services for adults and children. Dental treatment in the pre-doctoral clinic is rendered by their dental and dental hygiene students under the supervision of the faculty. Prospective patients interested in receiving dental care are primarily selected on the basis of their teaching potential. Special services are offered to children in the Pediatric Dentistry and Orthodontic Clinics. Fees may be paid in the form of cash, check or credit card. Payment is due on the date service is provided. Patients with insurance must also pay at the time service is rendered. The College of Dentistry will complete an insurance claim for submission to your insurance carrier for reimbursement.
