This office is also the single point of entry for families moving into the county whose preschool children have been previously identified and have a current Individualized Educational Program (IEP). Families with concerns about their preschooler's development, who are nonresidents of Montgomery County with a child attending a MSDE approved preschool within Montgomery County, may also contact the MCPS Child Find Office.
