Fact Sheet - Applying for an Enterprise License

Who must apply for an enterprise license? Anyone who intends to operate an amusement park, theaters, movie picture house, dance halls, for profit swimming pools, baseball, etc., parks, carnivals, circuses, roller skating rinks, miniature golf courses, driving ranges, pitch & putt courses and pony rings.

What is an enterprise? Any of the activities noted above.

When must one obtain an enterprise license? An enterprise license must be obtained prior to operating any of the above noted activities. . (This license does not apply in Chevy Chase Village, Town of Chevy Chase, Gaithersburg, Garrett Park, Kensington, Laytonsville, Poolesville, Rockville, Town of Somerset, and Washington Grove.).

How does one obtain an enterprise license? Applications and information on the required attachments are available from the Department of Health & Human Services, Licensure & Regulatory Services, 255 Rockville Pike, Suite 100, 1st Floor, Rockville, Maryland 20850, 240-777-3986. Applications are available on our website.

Fees: Payment can be made by check or money order, payable to "Montgomery County, Maryland" or by Visa or Mastercard or checking card. We are unable to accept cash payments.

Process

- Submit the license application and fee.
- Submit "Use and Occupancy Permit" and current Fire Marshall Inspection report. ALL APPLICANTS.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted or returned to the applicant.
- <u>New Establishments</u> need to have an advertisement published in the Washington Post for two weeks*.
- Customer must pay advertisement fee, which will be provided after advertisement is posted. Fees range from \$200-\$300. Customer pay fee once provided by our office.
- Application and attachments will be reviewed for approval and license will be issued.
- Personnel within Licensure & Regulatory Services are available to discuss questions during Business Hours (Monday-Friday) 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Telephone Number is 240-777-3986.

*Note: The license application for a newly established enterprise must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county for at least two weeks prior to issuing the license. Licensure & Regulatory Services arranges for the advertisement.
