SITE: 3 acre plot at corner of Montgomery Village and Christopher Avenues. Previous building was gutted on interior and additional space added around perimeter along with a new second floor.

LIBRARY DESIGN & FEATURES:

- Upgraded and modernized facility with energy efficient glass, heating, and cooling.
- Designed to LEED Gold certification, documentation is being assembled to submit to US Green Building Council
- Use of Vegetative Roofing and pervious pavement to control and filter storm water
- Adult, children's and teen materials collection on main level of library building
- 300 seat second floor meeting room with operable partition wall; small meeting room seating 85
- Landscaped courtyard with exterior seating
- Program room in Children's area
- 2 group study rooms for 6-8 individuals and 4 tutor rooms for 1-2 individuals in Adult Reading Room; 1 tutor room in Children's area for 1-2 individuals
- Computer lab with 12 PCs
- Discovery Center in Children's area
- Separate Teen area with seating and collection
- Ergonomically designed sit/stand workstations for staff at the checkout desk
- Audio loop system
- Coffee bar/café with café type seating
- Satellite office of the Charles W. Gilchrist Center for Cultural Diversity

SIZE: 62,505 gross square feet, including a 44,679 gross square foot first floor and a 7,897 gross square foot second floor. The previous Gaithersburg Library was 36,814 square feet on one level.

- 154 parking spaces for cars including 6 ADA accessible parking spaces
- 10 Parking spaces for fuel efficient cars
- 4 designated spaces for motorcycles
